<u>Content Knowledge and Organization:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The content is clearly and concisely written with a logical progression of ideas and supporting information. • Presentation has a logical, intuitive sequence of information. • Cues to information are clear and direct. 					
<u>Introduction and Abstract:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The introduction presents the overall topic and draws the audience into the presentation with compelling questions. • The abstract completely and succinctly describes the research project including all basic components: motivation for topic, methods employed, findings, and implications for the field of study. 					
<u>Poster Design:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graphics are used effectively to convey data, results, findings, and important information. • Fonts are easy-to-read and appropriate for headings and text. Use of formatting enhances readability. • Text is appropriate in length for the audience and point of the project. • There are no grammatical/spelling mistakes.
